The ROV encourages jurisdictions to provide a resolution as early as possible.
E- 89 to 0	June 3, 2021 to August 31, 2021	<sup>2</sup> <b><u>CONTRIBUTION / INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURES</u></b> Sums of \$1,000 or more to/from a single source must be reported within 24-hours. The Independent Expenditure report is required only for committees (not candidate controlled) that make independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more to support or oppose a single ballot measure or a single candidate.
E- 88	June 4, 2021	<b><u>LAST DATE FOR PROPONENTS TO WITHDRAW AN INITIATIVE</u></b> Last day for proponents to withdraw an initiative that qualified for the ballot.
E- 83	June 9, 2021	<b><u>LAST DAY TO AMEND OR WITHDRAW A MEASURE</u></b> Deadline for jurisdictions to amend or withdraw a measure from the ballot. The measure must be amended or withdrawn by resolution.
E- 84	June 8, 2021	<sup>1</sup> <b><u>DUE DATE FOR PRIMARY ARGUMENTS</u></b> February 11, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. is the deadline set by the Registrar of Voters for submitting primary arguments in favor of and against a measure.
