DATES	ACTIVITIES / DOCUMENTS
February 1 through May 2, 2017 (E – 90 to E)	<u>CONTRIBUTION/INDEPENDENT EXPENDITURES REPORT</u> Sums over \$1000 to/from a single source must be reported within 24 hours. The Independent Expenditure report is required only for committees (not candidate committees) that make independent expenditures totaling \$1,000 or more to support or oppose a single candidate or a single ballot measure.
February 3, 2017 (E – 88)	<u>DUE DATE FOR MEASURE RESOLUTIONS AND TAX RATE STATEMENTS *</u> Last day for jurisdictions to file a resolution calling for a measure election, and if applicable, tax rate statement.
February 7, 2017 (E – 84)	<u>DUE DATE FOR ARGUMENTS *</u> Deadline set by the Registrar of Voters for submitting arguments in favor of and against a measure.
February 14, 2017 (E – 77)	<u>DUE DATE FOR REBUTTALS AND IMPARTIAL ANALYSES *</u> Deadline set by the Registrar of Voters for submitting rebuttals to arguments in favor of and against and the impartial analysis.
March 23, 2017 (E – 40)	<u>F.P.P.C. 1st PRE-ELECTION STATEMENT DUE</u> Deadline for financial disclosure report Form 460 covering the period of 1/1/17 – 3/18/17.
April 3, 2017 (E – 29)	<u>FIRST DAY FOR MAILING OF VOTE BY MAIL BALLOTS</u> First day for mailing of Vote by Mail ballots.
April 17, 2017 (E – 15)	<u>LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE FOR THE ELECTION</u> Deadline to register to be eligible to vote in the May 2, 2017 election.
April 20, 2017 (E – 12)	<u>F.P.P.C. 2nd PRE-ELECTION STATEMENT DUE</u> Deadline for financial disclosure report Form 460 covering the period of 3/19/17** – 4/15/17.
April 25, 2017 (E – 7)	<u>LAST DAY TO REQUEST VOTE BY MAIL BALLOT BY MAIL</u> Deadline at 5:00 p.m. to submit a request for a Vote by Mail ballot to be mailed to voter.

June 1, 2017 (E + 30)	<u>OFFICIAL CANVASS OF VOTE</u> Registrar of Voters to certify election results by June 1, 2017.

This calendar may not contain all of a candidate's or district's filing requirements. The Registrar of Voters Office is not open for filings on Saturday, Sunday or holidays.

* The legal 10-calendar-day public examination period in which a writ of mandate may be sought begins immediately following the filing deadline for submission of those documents. The writ of mandate request shall be filed no later than the end of the 10-calendar-day public examination period.

** The period covered by any statement begins on the day after the closing date of the last statement filed, OR January 1st, if no previous statement has been filed.
