

The deadline for jurisdictions to file a resolution with our office, placing a measure question on the November 6, 2012 ballot, is August 10, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.

Arguments For or Against a County, School or Special District measure are filed with the Office of the Registrar of Voters. Arguments and their submission process must comply with all rules.

The deadlines for filing arguments for a County, School or Special District measure on the November 6, 2012 Ballot are as follows:

**Arguments in Favor for or Against a Measure
August 14, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.**

**Rebuttal Arguments to Arguments in Favor of or Against a Measure
August 21, 2012 at 5:00 p.m.**

Arguments For or Against a City measure are filed with each individual City Clerk's Office.

For City measures contact the City Clerk for the jurisdiction placing the measure on the ballot for filing deadlines and information.
