All candidate statement deposits and originally signed nomination documents, including a Declaration of Candidacy and nomination signatures, must be filed together in one packet with the County of Santa Clara Registrar of Voters' Office, Candidate Services Division no later than 5 p.m. by Friday, August 7th, in order to qualify as a candidate.

Except for those running for City offices, all candidates running for special district and school district offices are encouraged to be issued nomination papers electronically and must file nomination papers at the Registrar of Voters' Office, which is located at 1555 Berger Drive in San Jose, Building 2 by this Friday by 5:00 pm.

Candidates running for a City office – who have different filing requirements and deadlines – must pick up and file nomination papers with their respective City Clerks' Office.

A 2020 Presidential General Election Candidate Guide is available to assist those running for office, with valuable information pertaining to qualifications for office, terms of office, procedures, fees, forms, and deadline dates. The [Candidate Guide](#) is available at no cost and may be picked up from the Registrar of Voters' Office or downloaded from the Registrar of Voters' website, www.sccvote.org/candidatesandmeasuresinformation, under the Candidates & Measures tab.

The Registrar of Voters provides a daily updated unofficial list of candidates who have filed their documents in Santa Clara County. The unofficial list can be found on the County of Santa Clara Registrar of Voters' website www.sccvote.org at [Candidates](#) or by scanning the code at left. Under California Election Law, the deadline can be extended to Wednesday, August 12 for contests in which an eligible incumbent office holder does not file. The list of contests in extension will be posted on our website by Monday, August 10th.
