<b>STATEWIDE ELECTION DATES:</b> An election held in March, June or November of an even-numbered year (EC Section 1001)						
<b>OTHER ESTABLISHED ELECTION DATES:</b> 1st Tuesday after the 1st Monday in March of each odd-numbered year; 2nd Tuesday of April in each even-numbered year; 1st Tuesday after the 1st Monday in November of each odd-numbered year (EC Section 1000)
