Requirements

- ◆ Arrive at the polling place on Election Day at 7:00 am and 9am on Early Voting days

The Student Election Officer Program offers high school students the opportunity to work in a polling place on Election Day. Students provide invaluable service to their community, gain critical insight into the electoral process and can earn a stipend or community service credits for their efforts. Your son/daughter has expressed an interest and would like to volunteer. In order for us to assign a high school student under the age of 18, we must have the permission of the parent or guardian. The student's duties include completing a training class and assisting voters at the polling place throughout Election Day. The hours of participation on Election Day will be from 7am to approximately 8:00pm . Students also have the option of participating during our Early Voting Days from 9am-5pm. We endeavor to place students as close to home as possible, given availability. Students are responsible for their own transportation.
